The City of Memphis has entered into an agreement with Insight Public Sector, Inc. and with Taser International, Inc. to provide equipment, software, warranty, support, training, PSA and cloud storage
5. A resolution seeking acceptance of three SkyCop Camera Solutions, compatible with existing MPD equipment. The money is being raised by the resident of the Hedgemoor Neighborhood. The cameras will be placed at (1) Eastland and Minden Road (2) Walnut Grove and Saint Andrews Fairway and (3) Goodlett/Graham and Minden Road. The amount of the donation is \$23,509.14 and is donated to the Department by the Memphis/Shelby County Law Enforcement Foundation
6. A resolution seeking acceptance of three SkyCop Camera Solutions, compatible with existing MPD equipment. The money is being raised by the resident of the River Oaks Neighborhood.
